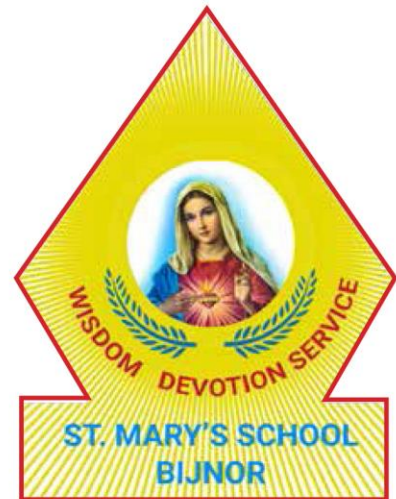

HINDI DIVAS is celebrated to mark the importance of the country's most widely spoken language. A special assembly was conducted on this occasion.



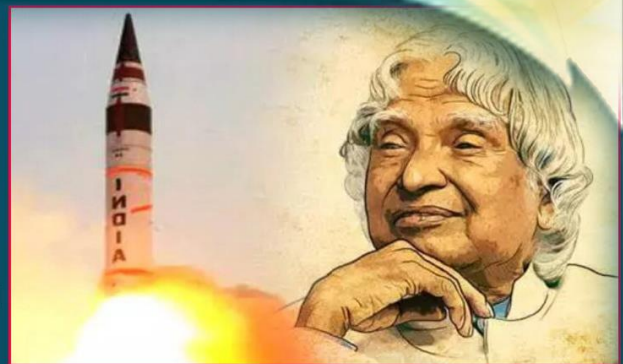
March 2020

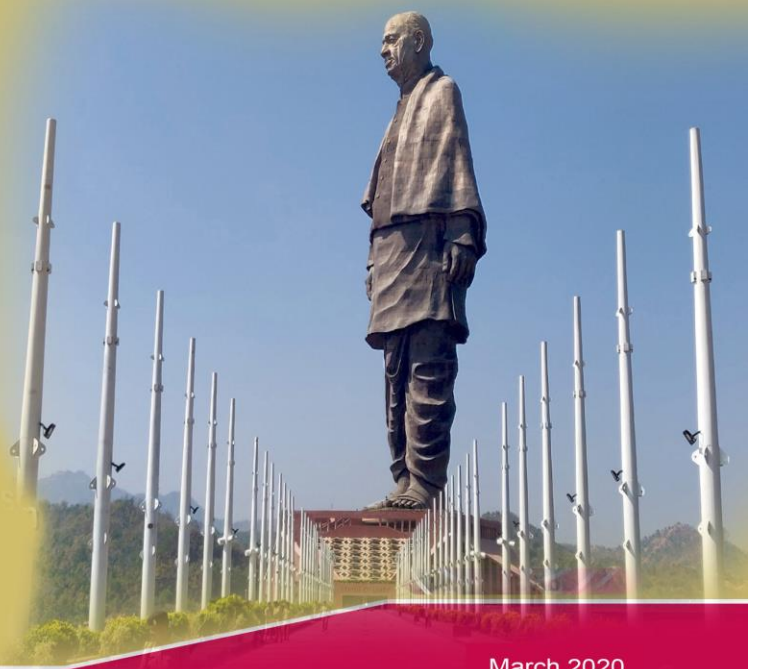
National Unity Day on 31st Oct, 19.

The Alumni Meet

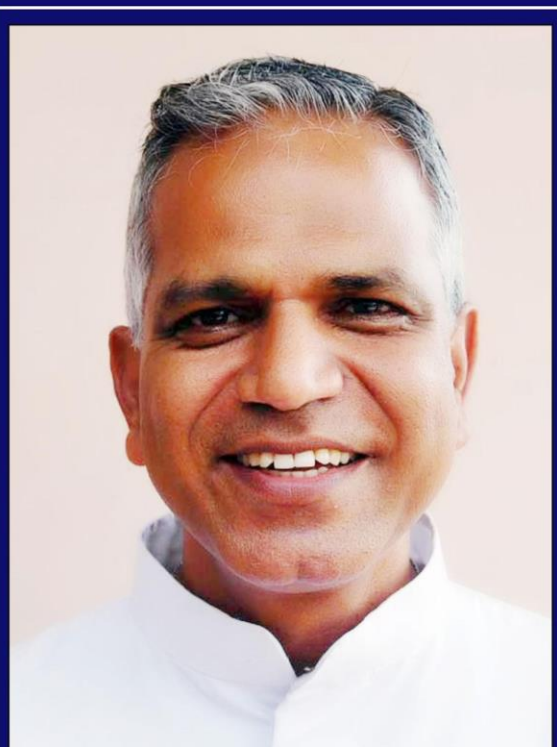

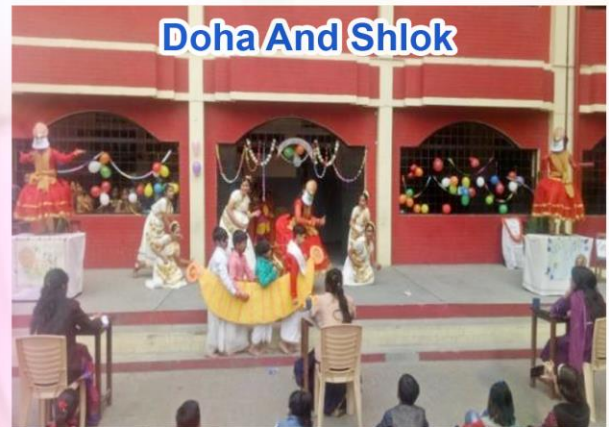

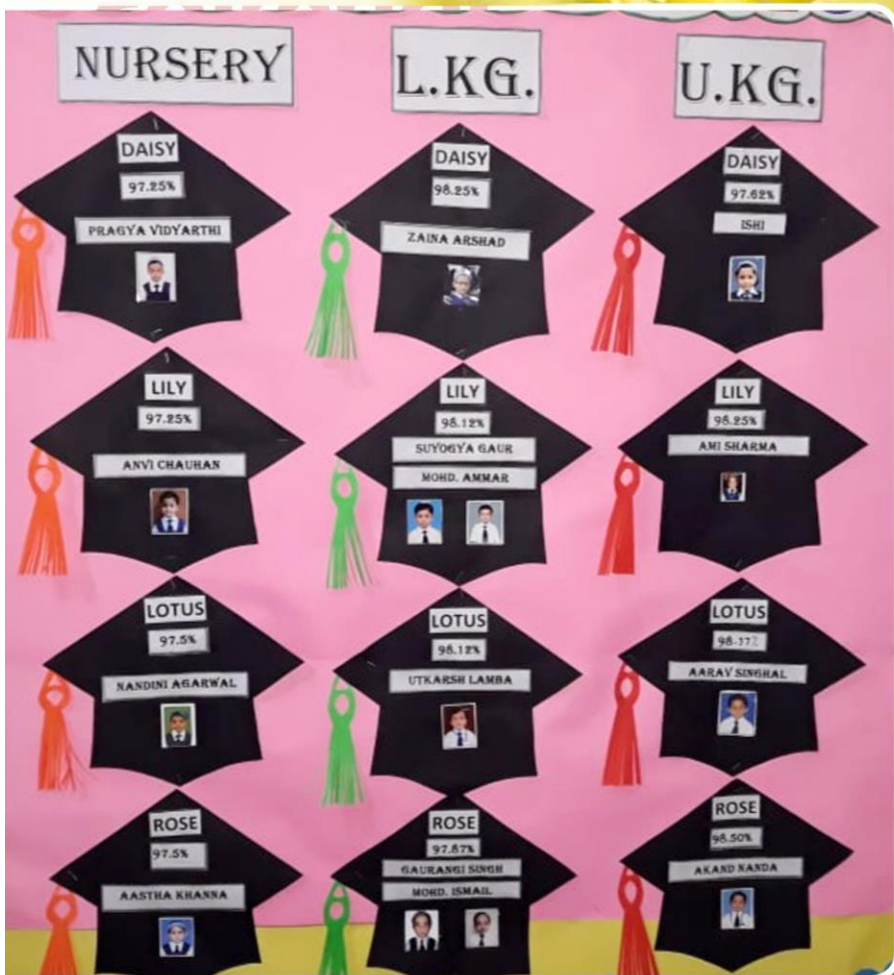
